Digitally manipulated campaign communications have the potential to drastically alter voters' perspectives of candidates and issues—which is especially harmful if they have been edited in such a way as to create a perception of events that have not occurred. Nevada voters deserve better than to face deception in matters as serious as elections, which is why we are in strong support of the disclosure requirements proposed in this bill. We appreciate the Secretary of State's office's leadership on this nuanced issue.

We urge you to pass AB73, allowing Nevada to join the other 20 states that have addressed this critical issue.
