Dear Assembly Ways and Means Committee:

This bill, even amended, does nothing to increase safety. It is a revenue-generating tool that will cost us \$4.5M in the first year and \$1M annually thereafter, but the point is to generate revenue (there is no speculation in the bill on what this program would bring in).

Nevada is going to be experiencing a \$191M shortfall in Revenue based on the Governor's Economic Forum. Why spend \$4.5M in year one without even an estimate of revenue generation?

This bill adds 105 portable electronic monitoring systems to our traffic management program in Nevada. More equipment, more monitoring, more repairs. It provides NO improvement in safety or speed reduction on our streets.

I am opposed to electronic surveillance systems, they reduce privacy by increasing surveillance. Those who want to find a way to cheat the electronic systems will do so, how many cars do you see on the road with no license plates?

This bill also requires automatic data capture and transmission, this requires system verification and testing regularly. Costs with no benefit identified...

Please oppose AB402 with amendment 319. This bill requires a huge cash expenditure, requires annual maintenance, increases surveillance of law-abiding citizens, treats citizens as revenue generators and does nothing to improve the safety of our streets.
